Tung ICMS) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University are organising the Sixth International Forum on Shipping, Ports and Airports (IFSPA 2013) in Hong Kong, China, from 3 to 5 June 2013.

Themed "Trade, Supply Chains Activities and Transport: Contemporary Logistics and Maritime Issues", IFSPA 2013 aims to provide an interactive platform for international academics, industry leaders and global stakeholders to consider future issues related to maritime and trade economics, policy and management. Author(s) should have direct involvement in the study being reported and deliver a 15-20 minute presentation during the Conference. We are looking for papers on (but not restricted to):

- Maritime Safety, Security & Piracy; Maritime Environment & Policy

- Supply Chain Management; Operations Management; Green Logistics
